

GRTC Transit System ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY


In support of our mission “to provide clean, safe, and reliable transportation to improve mobility and access throughout Central Virginia,” GRTC Transit System will establish, implement, and maintain an Environmental Management System (EMS) that conforms to the ISO 14001 EMS Standard. This standard provides a framework for the fulfillment of GRTC’s environmental responsibilities, and for the continual improvement of our environmental performance, while maintaining our focus on the safety of our employees, customers and the Greater Richmond community.

In the development of our Environmental Management System, GRTC will:

- Comply with all applicable legislative, regulatory, and internal requirements which relate to identified environmental aspects;
- Establish and monitor environmental programs;
- Continually improve performance and prevent pollution, where feasible, through process efficiency and improved technologies;
- Develop annual EMS objectives and targets, and review them periodically to encourage continuous improvement and to increase EMS and environmental performance;
- Evaluate environmental impacts;
- Reduce and recycle waste;
- Minimize or eliminate any adverse environmental effects our operations may have on our employees, customers and the communities in which we operate;
- Communicate our environmental policy to all GRTC employees and the public;
- Educate all GRTC employees about their roles and responsibilities regarding the environmental policy and our EMS, and provide appropriate training to ensure outstanding performance;
- Establish documentation and implementation procedures to ensure accountability.
