


WHAT WE HEARD

ACCESS TO SERVICES

Reliable, equitable access to jobs, schools, parks, and essential services, especially for vulnerable communities, is very important to this station.

SAFETY

Improved pedestrian safety is desired, including lighting to prevent crime, especially at high-speed corridors and key intersections.

TRANSIT-ORIENTED DEVELOPMENT

This station has high opportunity potential due to truck yards, surface parking, and car-oriented land uses.

There is a desire for converting industrial spaces to employment hubs, mixed-use development, or community services
