


WHAT WE HEARD

SAFETY & STREET DESIGN

Chamberlayne Ave is dangerous and needs safety upgrades, bike/pedestrian connections, and traffic calming.

REDEVELOPMENT POTENTIAL

This station is seen as an area of high redevelopment potential. A connection to VUU is envisioned as well as a desire for residential infill and vibrant public spaces.

Stakeholders are concerned about the Pulse's impact on the Chamberlayne Ave Corridor, including speeding, pedestrian safety, and loss of the shaded median.

WIDENING CONCERNS

DEVELOPMENT TYPE

Desired uses at this station include: residential, hotel, institutional, and civic/cultural.

PREVIOUS PLANS AND STUDIES

This station area overlaps with the 2015 VUU/ Chamberlayne Neighborhood Plan, and should consider recommendations on linking to Virginia Union University.

EQUITY & AFFORDABILITY

There is concern for displacement and gentrification and a desire to preserve the naturally occurring affordable housing along Chamberlayne Ave.
